Dear Dancers:

Please read this information carefully, it will explain everything you need to know about our January 28th Winter Recital. If you have any questions please ask and thank you.

* **Friday/Saturday, January 13 and 14th, Picture Day, at the studio.** Please arrive in your costume, with hair and make-up done 15 minutes before call time. Individual pictures of dancers will be taken during the class photo time. For dancers whose classes will not be taking a group photo, you may sign up for individual pictures.

* **On Saturday, January 21st at the studio: 12-3:00:** we will have a full dress rehearsal run through for all of our soloists in ACT 1, including The Dream Team, Dance the Magic team and all ballet soloists, from the audition. **DANCERS PERFORMING IN OUR BALLET CLASSES YOU DO NOT NEED TO ATTEND THIS REHEARSAL.**

* **FRIDAY, January 27th, will be our Dress Rehearsal at Orange Coast College. FOR ALL DANCERS PERFORMING IN THE RECITAL these are your CALL TIMES!**

* * **Dancers in ACT I need to arrive by 4:15 and be ready to start by 4:30. (You will not be allowed in the facility until 4:15) This includes Dream Team dancers and Disney Team Dancers. If your child is in Act I only, they will be dismissed around 5:30.**

*** **Dancers in Act II include all Ballet students in any ballet class and all Mermaid Soloists: ARRIVE AT 5:00 and be ready to start by 5:30. Rehearsal should conclude around 7:30.**

NO DANCER WILL BE DISMISSED UNTIL THE END OF THE REHEARSAL BLOCK. ONLY STAFF ARE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE. Parents you are welcome to wait in your cars or outside

at the picnic tables.

PLEASE NOTE:

I do my very best to run on time and keep distractions to a minimum. Dancers you must be ready to go at least 15 minutes before your scheduled dress rehearsal time or you may miss your run through. It is the dancers responsibility to be at the theater when they are needed. Please allow time for traffic and loading in/out of the theater.

* **Dancers:** You must sign in and out when you enter and leave the theater with one of our staff members at the door. Dancers will have an assigned dressing room which will be posted at dress rehearsal.; put your things in the dressing room and get ready for your first dance, by sitting in the dressing room lobby. Parents are not allowed to assist dancers backstage, so plan accordingly if you need to make several trips to your car. **THIS SHOW MOVES VERY QUICKLY AND THERE WILL NOT BE TIME TO SIT IN THE HOUSE TO WATCH THE SHOW.**

* **Please bring non- nut containing foods for snacks and lots of water.** There is an area to eat at the theater but no food is allowed in the dressing rooms. You can keep items in your dance bags, and eat in the backstage lobby.

Costumes and Valuables: Please label all of your costume pieces and bring a laundry basket or container to place all of your pieces in. Leave all valuables at home. The studio and the theater can not be responsible for lost items. All items recovered from the theater will be donated to charity at the end of the month.

* A professional videographer will be videotaping the performance; video links will be available for \$25.00 please sign up in the lobby if you would like to purchase a video link.

* Flowers/snacks and water will also be available for purchase the day of the show by cash, Venmo or credit card only. Food is not allowed in the theater; water only.

Please use this link to purchase tickets. Tickets will go on sale at NOON on Friday, December 9. All tickets are \$25, children 2 and under are free on a lap. Handicap seating is also available, in addition, the theater is easily accessible without stairs inside or outside of the venue. Please note I do not sell the first 2 rows of the theater for spectator comfort. Tickets purchased at the door the day of the show will be \$30.00.

Current Covid Regulations have lifted regarding mask wearing in the theater and backstage. Mask wearing is up to each individual. Should the situation change I will update everyone.

Make-Up:

Dancers in ballet level II and up and soloists:- please wear heavy street and water-proof make-up. This includes: foundation, neutral eye shadow, eye liner. black mascara, blush and red lipstick.. Do not wear nail polish or dangling earrings, diamond stud like earrings only. I have a limited supply of performance earrings both clip and pierced at the studio for dancers who would like to purchase them. \$10 while supplies last.
Dancers in Pre-Ballet and Ballet I level classes – just a little red lipstick.
